Deadline

The *initial* deadline for submission of this application to the college *registrar* **January 15**. Later applications will be considered, with deadlines of February 15, and March 15. After March 15, awards will only be made as long as funds are available.

General Information

Before completing this application, please read the student provisions and obligations for fellowship and grant in-aid as described in the current copy of the Official Bulletin of Au Sable Institute or on www.ausable.org. A fellowship normally covers the tuition of one course; a grant covers up to \$600 of tuition expenses. Fellowship recipients are normally not eligible for grants in the same session. Please remember that fellowships are only available in the five-week sessions and that recipients must take two courses during a session. The institute and the college institute representative will evaluate each student's qualifications and interest in environmental studies and select those most qualified to receive financial assistance. Notifications of fellowship and grant-in-aid awards will be on or before March 30th.

Application Procedure

Please download this form, complete it, and submit it to your official Au Sable Representative. Accompanying this form should be: the \$250 tuition deposit fee; a letter of Recommendation from your campus Au Sable Representative; a statement of financial need, and a copy of an Official Transcript. The home college may require application materials in addition to these forms.
